Technological training:

BASIC Cibernàrium Antennas

Short courses to get started and advance in the use of the internet and technology, to improve both professionally and in everyday life.

ESPECIALISED Cibernàrium

Short and medium-length courses on a variety of subjects aimed at employees, entrepreneurs and job seekers.

ADVANCED IT ACADEMY

Intensive and mentored long-term training in web programming and data science. Once the training has been completed, Barcelona Activa then supports participants in the job seeking process.

Equality between women and men in the workplace

Barcelona Activa is committed to achieving gender equality and eliminating the inequalities faced by women in the workplace. It offers various programmes and services aimed at the public and the business ecosystem, with objectives that include supporting female entrepreneurs and business leaders, promoting STEAM careers, improving women's skills in ICT, reducing occupational segregation, breaking the glass ceiling, improving job quality, eliminating the sticky floor, easing work-life balance challenges, and addressing the gender pay gap.

Support and guidance for businesses

Through the Advice Service for Equality and Time Organisation, companies and organisations receive personalised support from expert municipal staff. We also offer online courses on equality plans, protocols to prevent and deal with sexual and gender-based harassment, and measures for better time management and a co-responsible work-life balance.

Recognition of cultural diversity

Barcelona Activa strives to contribute to the recognition of a diverse and plural society. It has plans, actions and programmes aimed at specific groups with the objective of eliminating discrimination on the grounds of functional diversity, racial, ethnic and cultural origin, age, sexual and gender diversity, new arrivals and people with mental health problems.

Training

EQUITEST: a free and open-access self-assessment test that helps companies identify their strengths and weaknesses in terms of gender equality.

LGTBI GUIDE for incorporating sexual and gender diversity in companies, which provides guidance for integrating LGBTI talent into both public and private organisations.

STUDIES that analyse the origins and causes of inequalities between women and men in the labour market, offering proposals to eliminate these disparities and enhance the employability of women.
